CHAPTER V

5.1 Conclusion

The result of the research analysis shows the answer to the problem related in chapter 1 which are: The first what are pivot grammar found in the pupils utterances at At-taqwa playgroup, the second what are the meaning of the utterances contain pivot grammar produced by the pupils, and the third how do pupils in at- taqwa playgroup produce sentences in the form of pivot grammar. The following is presented to answer the first problem using the theory.

The pivot grammar used by pupil's utterance in age two to three years old is in fact not known by many pupils. By recording and analyzing the conversation they use everyday. The pivot grammar has pivot class and open class. It have function words and content words.

In reality, there are many activities that do by most pupils in the At-taqwa playgroup used pivot grammar, for example *kakak makan, aku hijau etc*. These words are pivot grammar part of Indonesian language. Then, analyses to meaning and describe about utterances use pivot grammar.

Finally, the writer concludes that there are 35 utterances analyzed. Those utterances from the pupils at At-taqwa playgroup age two to three years old. In the kinds of the pivot grammar mostly use pivot and open class have function and content word. Then, the meaning and describe of utterances produced by pupils in meaningless.

Especially for student of English department to study more about linguistic, especially grammar.
