CHAPTER V

5.1 Conclusion

5.1.1 What are the types of speech acts uttered by the main character in "All My Sons" by Arthur Miller

Based on the explanation and analysis from chapter four, the writer did not find declarations of illocutionary act classification in this study. Declaration of illocutionary act classification did not find in this one act play script because it is a speech that can change world by word such as President's speech. The writer found six types of speech acts from the three kinds of speech act and five classifications of illocutionary act occurring in "All My Sons" one act play script by Arthur Miller. They are locutionary act illocutionary act: representative, expressives, directives and commisives, and perlocutionary act.

5.1.2 Which are the most dominant speech acts frequently by the main character in "All My Sons" by Arthur Miller

Among these six types of speech acts that found in fourth chapter, directives of illocutionary act classification is the most dominant speech act used by main character (Joe Keller). This speech act create to get someone else to do

something. Commisives of illocutionary act classification is used in this one act play script because this act explains about what planned to do in future. For this script have many utterances that tell about plan in the time that will come. Not only explain what planned to do in the future but also a refusals, a promise and soon.

5.2 Suggestion

This chapter presents the suggestions which may be considered for the future researchers on speech acts. The first suggestion is future researchers can analysis not only from one act play script but also other resources from media such as radio, newspaper, magazine, etc by paying attention to the context of the conversation. The second, they can analyzed all types of speech acts as Locutionary act, illocutioary act include the classifications and perlocutionary act.

To conclude, the writer hopes that this research can give contribution and inspiration in analyzing other aspect of study such as the figure of speech, implicature of speech act, and intrinsic and extrinsic element of the literature's work connect to study of speech act. The last, the writer hopes that this study can be use as a reference for further researcher who may be interested in similar topic.
