

CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1. Background of study

These individuals also share the understanding of at least one language so they may communicate with each other.

According to Christopher Mcall (2003:235),

Language is central to the workplace in two ways. First, work, as a set of tasks individually performed and collectively integrated, requires different kinds and levels of communication. Second, in so far as the workplace is one of the principal sites in which people establish their social connections with others, language plays a central role as a social connector, binding together individuals, groups, and larger networks.

According nancy Bonvillain, Code mixing is a lainguistic process that material from a second language into a base language, adding morphological markers of the base to introduced element. It differs from code switching by more deeply integrating mixed material into the host linguistic system (2011:336).
