CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

Based on analysis of the data which has described in the previous chapter, researcher can conclude that:

- 5.1.1 According to first question about the form of Indonesian-English code mixing in Aneka Yess magazine. In this study only found six types of Indonesian-English code mixing. First is word substitution, there are some parts of word substitution; they are: noun, verb, adjective, adverb, conjunction and exclamation. Second is phrase substitution, it is a combination of two or more words that non-predicate. The third is word reduplication; it is repeating the same words. Fourth is hybrid, it has contrasted two components. They are: Indonesian affixes + English word and English word + Indonesian suffixes. Fifth is idiom, it creates new meaning that is different from the real meaning of each word. The last is clause, it is grammatical unit in the form of compound word at least consist of subject and predicate and potentially be a sentence. The form of Indonesian-English code mixing can be seen in following examples:
 - 1. Scrip sudah siap dan casting pemain akan dimulai tahun ini. This is examples of word.
 - 2. Punya sense of humor yang tinggi. This is examples of phrase.

- 3. *Kita bisa menjelajah dan menemui* spot-spot *keren*. This is examples of word reduplication.
- 4. *Kebanyang gimana* screaming-nya *para cewek*. This is examples of hybrid.
- 5. Siap bikin sesuatu yang up to date. This is examples of idiom.
- 6. *Siapa tahu* you are the next star in the entertainment world. This is examples of clause.
- **5.1.2** According to second question about factors cause Indonesian-English code mixing in Aneka Yess magazine, in this study also found three factors of code mixing used in the article. First factor is to show solidarity or familiarity, teenagers usually use code mixing to show solidarity with the group for relationship that more closed. Second is to show prestige or pride, teenagers also use code mixing to show their prestige related to a persons social status or their higher educational background. The last is to show relax, teenagers more interested use English words in their conversation or utterance, since such habits make them relaxed.

5.2 Suggestion

Researcher hopes that her study could improve knowledge and get information to the reader about code mixing. Researcher realizes that the research conducted so far from perfect. Researcher also hopes if there are other researchers who examine the same thing, it is expected to be more perfect and in wider scope.
