CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION & SUGGESTION

This chapter presents the conclusion and suggestion of the research based on the research finding in the previous chapter. It contains the result of the research and the suggestion for the next research. It include result the kinds of imagery and the ecological issues which the researcher find in William Wordsworth poems.

5.1 Conclusion

This research is focused on ecological issue in the three poems of William Wordsworth. Those poems are "The World Is Too Much With Us", Lines Written In Early Spring", and "I Wandered Lonely As A Cloud". Descriptive qualitative is used in this research. In the first question, the researcher finds several imagery in the William Wordsworth poem. In the first poem "The World Is Too Much With Us", the researcher finds visual imagery, auditory imagery, kinestethic imagery, and organic imagery. In the second poem "Lines Written In Early Spring", the researcher finds auditory imagery, tactile imagery, kinestethic imagery, and organic imagery. In the third poem "I Wandered Lonely As A Cloud", the researcher finds visual imagery, kinestethic imagery, and organic imagery.

After finding the imagery, she continues answer the second question. In the second question, the researcher finds the ecological issues in William Wordsworth poems using ecocriticism. In the first poem, the researcher finds the lesson of the simplicity on the nature, the lack of interconnection between human and nature, and meadow as the comfort place as the ecological issue. In the second poem, the researcher finds the destroy of nature and the hope of animal and plant as the ecological issues. In the third poem, the researcher finds daffodils as a moodbooster and the dancing of the waves as the ecological issues.
