CHAPTER III

METHOD OF RESEARCH

This chapter is very important in this thesis because this chapter provides the guideline of this research to get the analysis systematically. The researcher divides into five sub chapters, those are (3.1) research design, that is the strategy of analyzing the data, (3.2) source of data, that is the sources which the researcher gets of the data, (3.3) the data, that is the data which the researcher uses to do the research, (3.4) data collection, that is the way how the researcher collect the data, and the last is (3.5) data analysis, that is the procedure which the researcher did before writing this research.

3.1 Research Design

Research is a work to find scientific knowledge. Knowledge is all of thing which we know and it has a various number. Meanwhile the scientific is a knowledge which follows the rule of scientific. Although, it is not all science is got by research, the research has a strategic position of finding actual science.

The process of research involves emergingquestions and procedures, data typically collected in the participant's setting, data analysisinductively building from particulars to general themes, and the researcher making interpretations of the meaning of the data. The final written report has a flexible structure. Those who engage in this form of inquiry support a way of looking at research that honors aninductive style, a focus on individual meaning, and the importance of rendering the complexity.

3.2 Source of Data

Before analyzing data, the first thing that must be done by the researcher is determine the data. What data and where it is taken will be the important thing to be thought in advance. In this sub chapter, the researcher tells about where the source of data is taken before she does the analyzing data, the source of data in this research is *Of Mice and men*novella written by John Steinbeck in 1937. 3.3 The Data

3.4 Data Collection Techniques
