

## CHAPTER V

### CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

In this chapter, the conclusion is firstly described to draw the points that have been analyzed in the previous chapter. #### 5.1. Conclusion

Thematization can be every potential to bring particular meaning to the special positions in every statement. Hence, the speech “I Have a Dream” shows various statements’ organization. From the analysis in the previous chapter, it is mentioned that the statements in “I Have a Dream” are in the form of topicalization, pseudo-cleft and cleft. It means that there are various types of thematization that is able to consist within a speech. The topicalization has come as the most occurring thematization in “I Have a Dream.” It means that MLK mostly put the main message of the statements in the front position.

In the case of the speech “I Have a Dream”, thematization can be seen as one aspect that gives contribution to the organization of the statements and meaning. As for the organization of meaning, thematization has provided MLK with variety of organizing the structure of the statements. It can be seen that thematization serves as

the meant to enable MLK to draw his thought into the form of various word's structure. Intending to show that MLK has a dream to make the Negro live the same life as other American, MLK put the strong emphasis into the clauses that state the Emancipation Proclamation and the current condition of the Negro through organizing the words in various positions.
