CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

This is the last chapter of this research. After doing analysis and finding the results of the analysis, this chapter presents conclusion and suggestion.

5.1 Conclusion

After doing chapter IV that presents the analysis of the data and findings, the researcher wants to give a conclusion related to this research. Among ten dialogues that are used as the data, five topics that shows Rose's feeling of happiness and sadness are found out. The topics are; (1) Rose's Despair towards Her Own Life, (2) Rose's Spirit to Live Freely, (3) Rose's Misery to be with Cal, (4) Rose's Joy to be with Jack, and (5) Rose's Confusion about her Choice. In topic 1, there are three dialogues that are used as the data. In topic 2, there are three dialogues. In topic 3 includes two dialogues. In topic 4 and 5, each of them consists of one dialogue. Based on the analysis of each topic, most of Rose's feeling is in the psychological state of being sad. Her feeling of sadness is shown in topic 1, 3, and 5. Meanwhile, her feeling of happiness is shown in topic 2 and 4

The findings of the analysis show that Rose uses four types of illocutionary acts in her utterances. They are expressives, representatives, directives, and commissives. The type of illocutionary acts that Rose mostly uses is expressives. This indicates Rose's character as emotional woman. Then, the way Rose uses the utterance are in declarative, imperative, and interrogative sentences. The type of sentences that Rose mostly uses is declarative sentence. Lastly, most reasons Rose

uses in performing illocutionary acts are related to her feeling of either happy or sad. So, based on the conclusion, the theory of speech act proposed by Searle (1979) and Austin (1962) are important to be applied if researchers want to find the intended meanings of other people's utterances. However, each analysis of the utterance should be linked with situational context.

5.2 Suggestion

The researcher expects to give contribution through this research. Thus, after the analysis, she wants to propose suggestion. Since doing research related to speech acts theory has been common for many researchers, she suggests other university students to do researches about this theory but they have to link the theory of speech acts with other theory, such as psychological theory, happiness and sadness. So, the intended meaning of people's utterance, talking, or writing can be understood deeply. The researcher also suggests for other researchers to apply this speech acts theory in other objects or movies.
