

CHAPTER V
CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 CONCLUSION

Based on the research result and discussion, the researcher has come to the following conclusion. There are some uses of phoneme /r/ in the conversation. In the previous conversation, almost each statement contains a word bearing phoneme /r/. In speech communities used the uvularized /r/ is also influenced by the environment in communities Bangkalan. Generally, in Madurese, phoneme /r/ is produced by tapping the tip of the tongue to the post alveolar by thrilling action. In this particular Bangkalan speech community, however, this phoneme /r/ is produced by putting the back of the tongue close to the uvular and blow the air from the lung through the narrow opening between the back of the tongue and the uvular. This produces the sound /r/ as produced by French speakers that is generally transcribed /ʀ/. It takes place between another speakers of the same community.
