

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION

This chapter will present the conclusions and the suggestions of research based on the analysis and finding in previous chapter.

5.1 Conclusion

Through the analysis and finding, all problems in research question have been answered. This research has found out two kinds of speech acts used in contextual situation on Anas Urbaningrum's Speeches, they are: locutionary acts and 10 illocutionary acts. In Anas Urbaningrum's Speeches, this research found out 10 utterances containing locutionary acts and 10 utterances containing illocutionary acts. While perlocutionary acts can be found in Anas Urbaningrum's Speeches, because the data were taken in the form documentation and also no responses from from the journalist, KPK, and Sby as the hearers.

While in the classification of speech acts, there are fives categories illocutionary acts. They are: Representative, Expressives, Directives, Commissive, and Declarative. From Anas Urbaningrum's Speeches, this research founded out 1 Representative from the locutionary acts, 2 Expressives from the locutionary acts, 5 Directives from the locutionary acts, 1 Commissive from the locutionary acts, and 1 Declarative from the locutionary acts, most of them are Directives. These all are based on contextual situation on Anas Urbaningrums's Speeches.

And in the use of speech acts contextual situation on Anas Urbaningrum's Speeches, there are four structures of sentence, they are: Declaratives, Imperatives, Exclamatives, and Interrogative. This research found out 2 Declaratives are based on structure of sentences from the locutionary acts, 5 Imperatives are based on structure of sentences from the locutionary acts, 2 Exclamatives are based on structure of sentences from the locutionary acts, and 1 Interrogative and most of all are Imperatives.

5.2 Suggestion

Based on the analysis and finding, the researcher tries to give suggestions:

The researcher hopes to the next researcher to be able to investigate speech acts deeper from other types of speech. For the reader of Anas Urbaningrum's Speeches and other speeches can be expected to understand what the intended meaning of the speeches. Thus, the researcher also hopes this thesis gives a useful knowledge and insight to the readers.
