

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 Conclusion

Through the finding and analysis, all problems in the research questions have been answered. This research has found out the illocutionary acts used by Prabowo Subianto. Firstly, the types of illocutionary acts that contain of leadership behavior selectively analyzed how these illocutionary acts can be considered implies leadership behavior. Some illocutionary acts stated by Prabowo Subianto are considered as containing meaning which illustrate leadership behavior. And the identity how Prabowo Subianto uttered this illocutionary acts that shows the leadership behaviors. Then the reason these illocutionary acts uttered.

In the first questions, what kinds of illocutionary acts that shows the leadership behaviors delivered by Prabowo Subianto in this interview. The representative illocutionary acts dominated in Prabowo's utterance. Moreover, expressive and declarations illocutionary acts shown in PS's utterance. There are factors which indicated that illocutionary acts occurred in the interview between Babhita Sharma and Prabowo Subianto, such as grammar, grabbing turn-taking, and metaphors of rhetoric. All of them have important roles that can help the researcher identified how Prabowo Subianto can opened, deflected, interrupted, dominated, and repeated the utterances.

Secondly and third questions, how are these illocutionary acts delivered, and why are these illocutionary uttered. From the analysis, Prabowo Subianto used the utterances that illustrated his vision, passion, confidence and image building. From the utterances, Prabowo Subianto managed political public relations which an individual actor or organizations for political purposes, through purposeful communications and action, seeks to influence and to build then maintain beneficial relationship and reputations with public to help support his vision mission and achieved the goals.

5.2 Suggestion

Based on the finding and analysis, the researcher tries to give suggestions. The researcher hoped that this suggestion can help another researcher. The next researcher should analyze speech acts in spoken or written text more deeply. Even though the researcher used interview transcript in this analysis, does not mean that they have to use transcript too. Everything that consists of text can be analyzed through the speech acts, not only interview, but also novels, president's speech, radio talk show, or even advertisement in mass media. In addition, the researcher also suggests to the next researcher that analyze another leadership theory deeper.
