

## **CHAPTER V**

### **CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION**

In the last chapter, after analyzing and findings, the researcher presents the last part of the research which are conclusion and suggestion.

#### **5.1 Conclusion**

After analyzing the data, the suggestive words that are used by Derren Brown and Romy Rafael were in the form series of words. The series of words presented by Derren Brown and Romy Rafael as hypnotist can be viewed from different angles depending on the mode of delivery used to change the context. By giving suggestion through series of words, Derren Brown and Romy Rafael can make people do things that they consider unreasonable to be driven by the subconscious mind. In giving suggestion they intent to get the hearer obey by giving command or request to the hearer. From the result of the analysis, six selected hypnosis of Derren Brown and Romy Rafael, the suggestion which is used by them are classified into two categories, imagining and obeying the suggestion. Because their suggestion is used to make the hearers imagine and obey something as suggestion given by the speaker.

There are a few things or conditions that must be fulfilled before giving suggestion in a hypnotic process. The main thing is the subject (the hearer) follow all the suggestion given by the hypnotist. In the presence of a belief it will expedite the process of hypnosis because the person in hypnosis will provide fully concentration on the imagination and suggestion f hypnotist. Before performing hypnosis, hypnotist will usually do an introductory action while in command prior

to breathe, which aims to see anyone who is easily hypnotized in order to facilitate the process of hypnosis. Then, the next process of suggestion is aimed to deliver the subject (the hearer) to the hypnotic process.

As the researcher has mentioned earlier in analysis of the research, the suggestive words have a power to drive the hearers to follow all suggestion given by Derren Brown and Romy Rafael. In making the suggestive words to have power, Derren Brown and Romy Rafael used repetition in their hypnosis to make the utterance clearly and understandable. They also used pacing and leading technique to make the hearer easier to understand by inserting idea to clarify their suggestion. In delivering the suggestion, the utterance are in the form of present tense that is used to make the hearer may receive the suggestion effectively. Beside that, the suggestive words is in progressive form by conveying suggestion step by step used to help in making the utterance easier and more effective to obey in bringing the hearers to hypnotic state. Derren Brown and Romy Rafael use suggestive words in hypnosis that is used for sending a message and obey commands or request that is conveyed when giving suggestion. From various aspects of this research, the researcher can describe that a more important role in hypnosis is the object (the hearer) who have successfully tied a confidence to hypnotist and high concentration to enter hypnotic state to follow all the suggestion.

After doing the analysis of the research, the researcher would like to give some suggestions regarding to the topic of suggestive words in hypnosis. The

researcher hopes that this analysis will bring benefits for readers or other researchers.
