

## CHAPTER III

### STUDY METHODOLOGY

#### 3.1 Sources of Data

Sources of data that is used in the study are English books and *Mandarin* books. Those books help to find the differences between English and *Mandarin* Structure by comparing the sentences. The books are Let's Write English (Revised Edition) by George E. Wilson, A. Shomad Robith with his book *Tata Bahasa dan Penggunaan Kata Bahasa Inggris*, Betty Schramfer Azar iwith her book *Fundamental of English Grammar*, *Xue Hanyu Hen Rongyi* ( 学汉语会话 ) by Fransisca Selvia, *Bahasa Mandarin Untuk Pemula 1* and *Pelajaran Bahasa Mandarin Modern* by Tan Tiong Hwat, and Peter Chen with his book *Bahasa Mandarin Modern*.

#### 3.2 Study Methodology

The type of this study is qualitative descriptive and uses comparative method. Descriptive method is used to give explanation about sentences in both language, English and *Mandarin*, in this case, the sentences are simple, compound, and complex sentences. And comparative method is used to find the differences and similarities by comparing the sentences in both languages.

#### 3.3 Technical Collecting Data

In this study, the writer used Library Research. Library Research was done to collect book references as sources to write the thesis. In Library Research, the

writer found description about sentences and the part of them which then was used to give brief explanation about sentences.

Then, the writer found the examples of sentences in both language that were used to compare both languages and to find the differences and similarities between them.
