

CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTIONS

This chapter covers conclusions and suggestions based on the research that was conducted.

5.1 Conclusion

This study analyzes English worksheets by employing analysis. Therefore there are two objectives of this research. First, content analysis based on BSNP criteria and second is analysis classification of Task instructions in taxonomy bloom revised. Based on the research result, some conclusion are explain as follow:

- a. The result of analysis English worksheet “BAHASA INGGRIS”, worksheet fulfill criteria of content by BSNP by gained 97% fulfillment and categorized as “good” worksheet.
- b. It can be concluded that both LOTS and HOTS are manifested on the worksheet Task instructions. And Task instruction in English worksheet “BAHASA INGGRIS” classified as HOTS

c. Suggestion

There are several suggestions that can be given Taskng into account the research findings that have been given previously. The suggestions given are expected to be useful for all parties involved in the use of LKS. Detailed suggestions are as follows:

- a. The Suggestion for English teachers of Junior High School

Researchers suggest that teachers can use complementary books from other sources to get explanations of complex material. The

locality aspect is the next aspect that needs to be added so that students increase their awareness of local and national aspects and maintain their national identity.

b. Suggestion for the Next Researcher

Supporting learning materials and presentation coverage are the aspects that need more attention. This is because less completeness of material resources can affect students' development. MGMP, TEFLIN and JETA are proposed as a solution to overcome these problems. It looks beneficial because the teacher is considered as the party who understands student needs.

c. Suggestion for the Researcher

The researcher has done a content analysis of English worksheet for eighth grade students of Junior High School. The next studies should explore how teachers solve the problems found in the worksheet or how far the problems may affect the teaching and learning process.
