CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION AND SUGGESTION

5.1 CONCLUSION

In this chapter, the researcher focused on the main female character, Carol Danvers. There were two problems in this research. The first was how to analyze the characteristics of Carol in the film script and by using the characterization theory of Boogs. In the first problem, the researcher found seven characteristics of Carol, including Curious, intelligent, brave, strong, optimistic, heroic, and independent.

The second problem was to analyze how liberal feminism was reflected through Carol's character. Based on the analysis, the researcher concluded that there was a liberal feminism in the main character in the Captain Marvel film. Women were no longer depicted as weak. Carol broke the stereotype that women should stay at home doing household chores, but carol displayed a strong woman figure according to what she wanted, led, and protected many people.

In liberal feminism, women strove for freedom because they were sometimes limited in doing something.

The third point was equal education. Liberal feminism was related to education. Carol wanted to fight for equal education for herself and women to experience a good education and had the same rights to relish education in the same way as men.

The last point was Carol's capacity to think and deal with situations. Carol could solve problems well by making the right decisions to secure the core energy. It showed that Carol was a good leader because she put the interests of many people above hers.
